Items MUST be sorted in separate piles and keep 3ft away from garbage container.

REMINDER: Do NOT put piles out until after your garbage pick-up day May 12-16.

## Each bagged or boxed items must weigh 50lbs or less.

PLEASE Group these materials as follows.

Pile #1 • Furniture

- General household items
  - o Toys
  - Home décor
  - Dishes
  - Clothes
  - Rugs
- Plastics
  - Shelving
  - Containers
- Mattress/Box spring
- Paint must be completely dried out w/ lids off (kitty litter, saw dust, or floor dry work best)
- Carpet 3ft or smaller pieces

Pile #2

- Minimal 4yd dumpster or less -Construction Material
- Sheetrock
- All wooden furniture
- Carpet over 3ft long
- Windows
- Toilets
- Wood 8ft max length
